## MHRI Membership

We encourage all horsemen racing in the state of Minnesota, at Running Aces and in MHRI-sponsored fairs, to become members. Membership applications can be found at [mnharness.com/membership](http://mnharness.com/membership) or use the one included in this booklet.

### Benefits of Membership:

- **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY** – The Harness Horsemen International (HHI) \$4,000 Scholarship is available to children of members who belong to an HHI-affiliated association. Applicants must complete and submit an official application to be considered.
- **ELIGIBILITY** – Opportunity to run for election to the MHRI Board of Directors.
- **VOTING PRIVILEGES** – Voting rights in MHRI Board of Directors elections.
- **INVOLVEMENT** – Opportunities to serve on select MHRI committees.
- **PARTICIPATION** – Eligibility to race in MHRI Fair races.
- **REPRESENTATION** – Advocacy on behalf of members with elected officials, regulatory agencies, the Minnesota Racing Commission, and Running Aces.
- **LIMITED FIRE AND DISASTER INSURANCE** – Coverage for eligible member-owned Standardbred horses while at scheduled racetracks, training centers, or fairgrounds, including up to \$15,000 for a horse that is racing, up to \$5,000 for a horse in training, and up to \$3,000 per horse for tack (maximum \$10,000 tack coverage per owner).
- **SULKY/JOG CART INSURANCE** – Coverage of up to \$1,750 for a damaged sulky or jog cart (see policy for full details).
- **THIRD PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE** – Provides liability coverage for owners of Standardbred horses in the event of bodily injury or property damage caused by their horse. Policy limits are \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 aggregate.

## MHRI Fair Racing Conditions

MHRI races under the rules and regulations of the United States Trotting Association. In addition, the following conditions and policies will govern races at MHRI-sponsored meets:

- Entry fees: \$40.00/race  
\*Horses may only enter in a single race at each fair.
- Proof of negative Coggins test within the last year is required at all race meets.
- Per Rule 13, Section 13.05 of the USTA rules: In overnight events, if there are less than 5 starters, the premium for the positions for which there are no starters may be retained by the association.
- In the event of a rainout, if the race is not rescheduled, the money may be carried over to the next year at the discretion of MHRI.
- Races at MHRI-sponsored meets in Minnesota may be officially charted based on the preference of the majority of participating horsepersons.
- MHRI reserves the right to split classes based on entries received and track conditions.
- MHRI provides race-day accident insurance coverage for all drivers participating in MHRI-sponsored race meets.
- Horses may be subject to drug testing at any MHRI-sponsored meet at any time, both pre- and post-race. Approved medication thresholds will mirror the standards and testing levels used at Running Aces.
- Breathalyzer testing may be conducted at all MHRI meets. Individuals subject to testing include drivers, anyone warming up a horse, and appointed officials.

## MHRI Fair Racing Conditions (Continued)

- The following point system will be used at MHRI-sponsored race meets to determine Fair year-end awards for horses, drivers, and trainers:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place	50 Points
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	25 Points
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	12 Points
4 <sup>th</sup> Place	8 Points
5 <sup>th</sup> Place	5 Points

For the purposes of eligibility and race conditions outlined in this booklet, a “MN-Owned” horse is defined as one in which at least a 50% ownership interest is held by a Minnesota resident. Residency will be determined in accordance with guidelines established by the Minnesota Department of Revenue.

**All owners, trainers, and drivers must be MHRI members to participate in fair racing. Non-members may join MHRI on race day to become eligible.**

## Minnesota-Bred Races at Running Aces

Champions for the 2- and 3-year-old divisions will be determined by the highest money earners in Minnesota-Bred Restricted races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet. Aged division champions will be determined by the highest money earners in all races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet. Earnings include those from Night of Champions, but do not include fair race earnings.

### 2- and 3-Year-Old Schedule

Two-year-olds are scheduled for 8 dates for each gait.

Three-year-olds are scheduled for 12 dates for each gait.

All gaits will also have finals held on Minnesota Night of Champions.

2 YO Trotters	Tuesdays	Beginning June 23
2 YO Pacers	Tuesdays	Beginning June 23
3 YO Trotters	Sundays	Beginning May 31
3 YO Pacers	Thursdays	Beginning May 28

If a Minnesota-Bred race is canceled due to circumstances beyond MHRI's control (such as technical issues, power outages, or weather), those races may be rescheduled on dates originally designated for Open 2- and 3-year-old races. If some divisions were completed prior to the cancellation, purses for divisions that were not contested may be distributed equally among the entered horses. Any other circumstances will be handled at the discretion of the MHRI Board of Directors.

## **Creating Full and Balanced Fields for 2- and 3-Year-Olds**

If possible, races will be split by sex. Uneven fields may be contested to facilitate splitting by sex if the minimum number of starters is met. A minimum of 5 entries may be carded to race after consultation between the Director of Racing and MHRI.

If there are not enough entries to divide races by sex, horses will be placed into A/B/C divisions as follows:

- 2 YOs: divided by lifetime earnings
- 3 YOs: divided by earnings from their last 4 starts

If divisions cannot be split evenly, the A division will have the fewer number of starters.

If a scheduled race is split into three divisions, horses may be divided by sex (resulting in two divisions of one sex and one division of the other), or all three divisions may be split according to the following conditions:

- 2 YOs: divided by lifetime earnings
- 3 YOs: divided by earnings from their last 4 starts

In an A/B/C format, divisions will be split as evenly as possible. If an equal split is not possible, the A division will have the fewest starters, followed by B, with C having the most.

Divisions may be created by sex or earnings to produce the most balanced and competitive fields possible. Any other division scenarios will be determined by the Director of Racing in consultation with MHRI officers.

If a class does not fill with at least 6 separate betting interests, the Director of Racing, in consultation with MHRI officers, may designate the race as a non-betting race.

If a race has 3, 4, or 5 separate betting interests, it may be conducted as a non-betting race. If only 1 or 2 horses are entered, each will receive 37.5% of the posted purse.

To promote competitive racing, any horse that wins 3 consecutive Minnesota-Bred races or 3 of the last 4 Minnesota-Bred starts will be assigned the outside post. This does not apply to horses moving from B or C divisions into Class A. Additional situations that result in negative betting pools may also be addressed following consultation with MHRI officers.

## Purse Structure for 2- and 3-Year-Old Races are as Follows:

Each scheduled race for 2 YO and 3 YO MN-Breds will have an estimated total purse of between \$21,000 to \$55,000.

- **1 Division**
  - A single division will race for \$21,000.
  
- **2 Divisions**
  - **Split by sex:** Each division will race for \$17,500.
  - **Split by earnings:** The A division will race for \$21,000 and the B division will race for \$14,000.
  
- **3 Divisions**
  - **Split by earnings:** Added monies will be applied to the base purse, resulting in purses of \$21,000 for the A division, \$14,000 for the B division, and \$8,500 for the C division.
  
  - **Split by earnings and sex:** When entries require three divisions, but one sex has enough horses to race together in a single division, that division will race for \$17,000. The other sex will race in A and B divisions, with the A division racing for \$17,000 and the B division for \$8,500.

Purse levels may be adjusted at the discretion of MHRI and Running Aces.

## Incentives for MN Breds

- MN-Bred horses will receive an extra win in non-restricted, non-winner classes (excludes maidens).
- MN-Bred horses will receive an extra 30% in money earnings in non-restricted conditioned races. Ex. non-winners of \$5,500 (MN \$7,150) in last 4 starts.
- MN-Bred horses that finish 1, 2, 3 in non-restricted races at Running Aces will receive a 30% bonus on those earnings.
- MN-Bred horses will receive a 50% allowance in claiming races.
- In accordance with Minnesota rule 7884.0130 Subp. 1a. A3. a: **Preference date:** When matching dates occur for two consecutive dates, preference will be given to state-bred horses over non-state-bred horses.

## 2026 Minnesota Night of Champions Conditions

2026 Night of Champions is Saturday, September 19 – 6 PM Post Time.

Fields for Night of Champions will be limited to the top 9 money-earning entrants eligible for the championship race.

For 2- and 3-year-olds, eligibility will be based on money earned in Minnesota-Bred Restricted races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet. If all divisions of the same gait, age, and sex are not contested on a given night, earnings from any non-contested division will not count toward finals qualification.

Eligibility for aged horses will be determined by total money earned at Running Aces during the meet.

If more than 9 horses are entered for a division final, consolation race(s) may be conducted for the remaining entrants.

To be eligible for finals or consolation races, all horses must have at least **two starts or qualifiers in Minnesota during the 2026 racing season.**

A Final must have at least six separate betting interests at the time of the draw to be considered filled. If the event does not fill, the finals may be contested as a non-wagering race following consultation between the Director of Racing and MHRI officers.

All Finals must be contested.

All earnings will be calculated from May 17, 2026, up to and including September 13, 2026.

Ties will be broken by the horse with the most starts in Minnesota. If still tied, the tie will be broken by lot.

All finals will be contested for the advertised purse.

At the discretion of MHRI, finals purses are subject to change due to significant unforeseen circumstances over the course of the racing season.

There will be no entry fee for Finals. All horses must meet current qualifying standards established by Running Aces and the Minnesota Racing Commission at the time of entry. Qualifying races will be held on the Sunday prior to the draw for Night of Champions.
